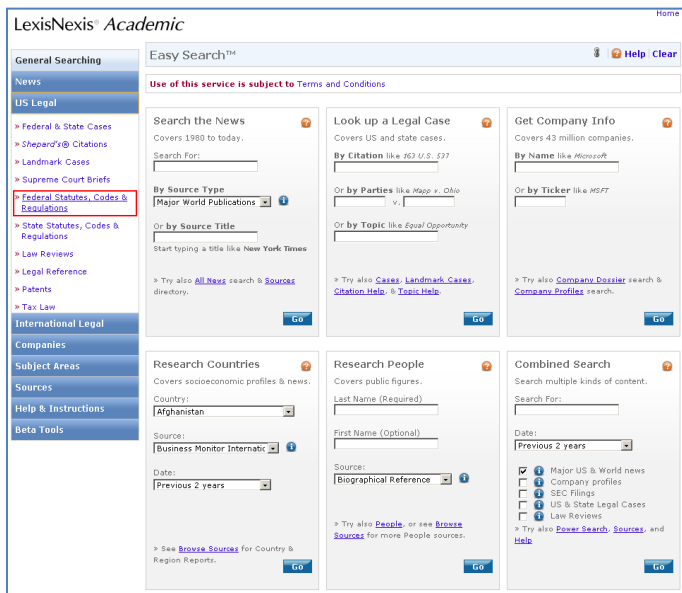

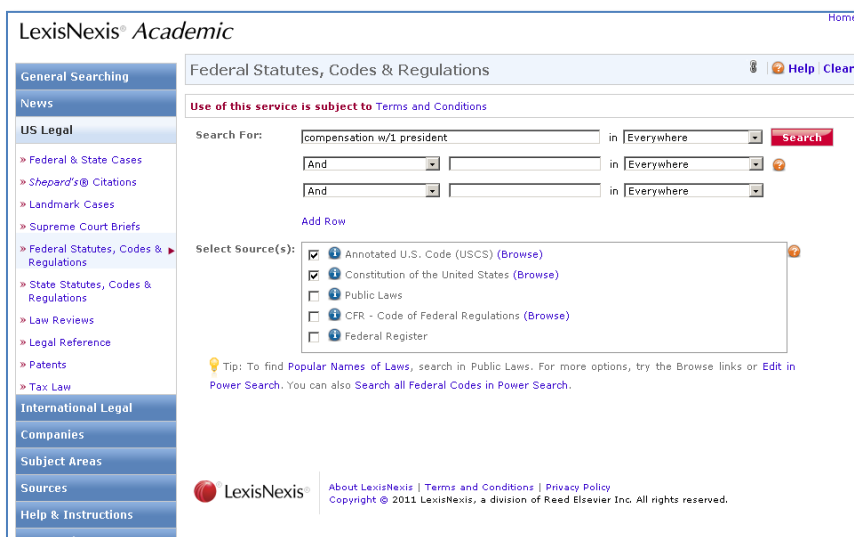

§ 102. Compensation of the President

The President shall receive in full for his services during the term for which he shall have been elected compensation in the aggregate amount of \$ 400,000 a year, to be paid monthly, and in addition an expense allowance of \$ 50,000 to assist in defraying expenses relating to or resulting from the discharge of his official duties. Any unused amount of such expense allowance shall revert to the Treasury pursuant to [section 1552 of title 31, United States Code](#). No amount of such expense allowance shall be included in the gross income of the President. He shall be entitled also to the use of the furniture and other effects belonging to the United States and kept in the Executive Residence at the White House.

INTRODUCTION:
The parties were two wealthy Russian businessmen, with interests in, among other things, television, oil and aluminium. Both parties had interests in 'Sibneft', an oil company, and 'Rusal', an aluminium company. The claimant alleged that he had been induced by intimidation to dispose of his interest in Sibneft to the defendant at a reduced price. He sought to recover his loss as compensation for the tort of intimidation. He further claimed that in breach of fiduciary or contract duty the defendant had disposed of a large number of shares in Rusal to companies controlled by D, rendering the claimant's shares much less valuable. The claimant sought to recover that loss as compensation for the alleged breaches of duty. The defendant applied unsuccessfully for summary judgment/and or strike out of the claims (see and). The instant proceedings were interlocutory applications by the defendant for an order that specific disclosure in relation to the 'Patakarsishvili materials' be provided by the claimant and for permission to re-amend its defence to withdraw the admission that English law was the law of the alleged Sibneft tort and to substitute Russian law as the appropriate law.

In relation to the disclosure application, the defendant based his application on the fact, inter alia, that there had been extensive deployment that had already been made in court of parts of the Patakarsishvili materials in order to defend the defendant's summary judgment application in the High Court and Court of the Appeal. Accordingly, it was submitted that, having so deployed part of the privileged communications in relation to the merits of the claimant's claim, the claimant had waived any privilege which he might have had in the Patakarsishvili materials, and was therefore now obliged, by the application of the principle of collateral waiver, to give disclosure of all documents relating to the same subject matter. Reliance was placed on the decisions of *Dunlop Slazenger International Ltd v Joe Bloggs Sports Ltd*, *Somatra Ltd v Sinclair Roche & Temperley* as well as *Derby v Weldon* to support the submissions that: (a) deployment of privileged material in interlocutory proceedings did generally suffice to engage the principle of collateral waiver; and (b) where such deployment addressed to the merits had taken place in an interlocutory hearing, it was not possible to 'turn back the clock' by deciding not to deploy the privileged evidence at trial. In relation to the application for permission to amend the defence to plead Russian law as the governing law, consideration was given to CPR 17, 14 and para 7.2 PD14. The claimant opposed the application on the basis, inter alia, that it would delay its trial preparations thus causing them real prejudice.
